- Plan, organise and deliver an appropriate learning programme that guides and encourages learners to develop and fulfil their academic potential in engineering.

Generic requirements

- Provide a variety of learning materials and resources for use in educational activities, and identify and select different resources and methods to meet learners' varying needs.
- Use relevant technology to support the learning process and ensure that all such learning resources are available to learners.
- Keep up to date with developments in the subject area, teaching resources and methods, and make relevant changes to schemes of work and lesson plans as appropriate.
- Ensure support staff are fully briefed on the roles they will undertake in supporting the learning process.
- Be responsible for the academic achievement of learners within the relevant teaching group, including observing and evaluating learners' performance and development, setting and grading learners' work, providing appropriate feedback and encouraging and monitoring the progress of individual learners.
- Maintain accurate and complete electronic records of the progress of all learners within the relevant house group.
- Manage learner behaviour in the learning environment by establishing and enforcing rules and procedures in accordance with the rules and behaviour management systems of The JCB Academy.
- Be responsible for the behaviour of learners within the relevant teaching group and take appropriate action as required to support learners and staff.
- Participate in extra curricular activities such as social activities, sporting activities, clubs, learner organisations, residential and enrichment days.
- Participate in subject and school meetings, parent/carer meetings and communicate necessary information regularly to learners, colleagues and parents/carers regarding learner progress and learner needs.
- Carry out additional tasks at the request of the Principal.
